Certificate IV in Kinesiology (HLT42807)



Description: Certificate IV in Kinesiology is a nationally recognised qualification intended to provide students with the necessary skills to become a respected professional practitioner with industry recognition.

This comprehensive course is structured into 9 integrated modules comprised of a combination of face-to-face training and self-paced computer based (on-line) training. The modules are assessed via in-course assessments (practical, oral & written), assignments (self-study i.e. at home) and on-line written assessments.

Duration: This qualification is conducted over 12 months with all components to be completed within 2 years. Our courses are designed to be flexible in their delivery so many campuses offer schedule variations and/or accelerated learning opportunities which may allow you to complete the course in less than 12 months (e.g. 6 months).

Certificate of Solution Oriented Neuro-Training

Description: The Certificate of Solution Oriented Neuro-Training (SONT) is an internationally recognised qualification with industry accreditation by the Australian Kinesiology Association (AKA).

Module Descriptions

MODULE 1: The Art of Solution Oriented Neuro-Training

Description: This module introduces the wonderful world of our neurology, our nervous system and our subconscious. Learn how to access the nervous system and the subconscious using muscle monitoring and how to resolve stresses. Learn about circuits, pre-checks, defences, the solution oriented procedure, the Model of Universal Principles and dehydration. MODULE 2: Principles of Recuperation

Pre-requisite: MODULE 1: The Art of Solution Oriented Neuro-Training

Description: In this module we work with the processes of recuperation and regeneration: how to work within the Universal Laws of Recuperation, how to recognise when symptoms are a problem or merely indicating a recuperation process. You will learn how time influences our ability to be well. You will learn skills to check for elemental, nutritional and energetic influences that may be limiting the recovery process. The second part of this module introduces you to 16 different muscle/meridian/organ circuits and all within 4 different phases of muscle monitoring, enabling you to access a multitude of circuits within the person.

MODULE 3: Blueprint One

Pre-requisite: MODULE 1: The Art of Solution Oriented Neuro-Training

Description: This module is directed at clearing away the restrictive inherited patterns that influence our behaviours. You will learn how Cheirology (hand analysis), used as a reference, can clear specific subconscious emotional and mental stresses. You will learn unique and powerful integration skills to remove specific psychological defences. Blueprint One includes understanding and skills for developing your personal awareness and self reliance. Some of the skills in this workshop are: defusing brain functions, fear, time line, learned helplessness and negative self behaviours.

MODULE 4: Innate Intelligence

Description: There are many ways of expressing our Intelligence and in this module we work with 9 forms of intelligence in a very congruent and empowering way. When we don't use our intelligence, fears and habits become locked into our physical body. In this module you will learn many skills for changing these patterns and enhancing the expression of the intelligences. Some of the skills included in this module are: hierarchy, laws of recuperation, hypertonics, reflexes, intelligences, reactive/reactor circuits, tendino-muscular meridians, and cerebellar techniques.

MODULE 5: Integration

Pre-requisites: Modules 1 - 4

Description: Understanding new information and acquiring new skills becomes a powerful combination when applied with artistry. In this module we synthesise the artistry of the practitioner, consolidating the application of the work into client driven and solution orientation. You are now applying your skills to train a person's neurological activity to respond in an intelligent way rather than operating from ancestral habits. Some of the skills in this module are: meridian science, dichotomy, unfinished business, acquired behaviours, chakras and their connection to the nervous system, essences, viscera and cranials.

MODULE 6: Client Care

Pre-requisite: MODULE 5: Integration

Description: In this 6th module, we bring your Neuro-Training and Kinesiology skills together with the management of the client, from marketing your Neuro-Training with Kinesiology practice, to working through a session and client follow up. Some of the skills in this module are: interviewing a new client, obtaining a history, putting the client at ease, determining the priority issue, engendering self responsibility, dealing with people from different cultures, beliefs and languages, recognising and respecting boundaries, identifying contraindications, and making referrals. During this module you will also be working in the student clinic, doing sessions with clients.

MODULE 7: Anatomy and Physiology 1

Description: This subject covers how the body is organised from molecular level to systems level and includes anatomical and medical terminology. Learning about functions and organisation of the human body is an excellent general foundation in the field of natural therapies.

Note: This module is delivered and assessed via self-paced computer based training (on-line) by our Training Partner Premier College in Sydney.

Delivery: 4 hours per week over 10 weeks

2009 Schedule: Commencement is at any time.

Assessment: Weekly questions submitted on-line with a 100% success rate requirement. A written exam is to be completed at Week 10.

MODULE 8: Anatomy and Physiology 2

Pre-requisite: MODULE 7: Anatomy and Physiology 1

Description: This subject covers the structure and function of the muscles and joints. We examine the basic concepts of biomechanics, joint and muscle construction and function and identify the major bony and soft tissue structures of the musculoskeletal system. You will also develop musculoskeletal and postural assessment techniques.

Note: This module is delivered and assessed via self-paced computer based training (on-line) by our Training Partner Premier College in Sydney.

Delivery: 4 hours per week over 10 weeks

2009 Schedule: Commencement is at any time.

Assessment: Weekly questions submitted on-line with a 100% success rate requirement. A written exam is to be completed at Week 10.

First Aid

Part of the requirement for the Certificate IV in Kinesiology is completion of the common unit HLTFA310B Apply First Aid. This unit is delivered and assessed through a number of national organisations such as St Johns Ambulance and Australian Red Cross.

Students will need to show evidence of completion of this unit as part of obtaining the Certificate IV in Kinesiology (HLT42807) from College of Neuro-Training.

Fees for this unit have **not** been included in the overall costs quoted in this prospectus.

About Premier College

In 2008 College of Neuro-Training formed an alliance with Premier College for the delivery of Anatomy and Physiology 1 & 2 and Practice Management via their on-line training service. This alliance allows College of Neuro-Training to deliver our Certificate IV qualification on a national level. Premier College is an RTO based in Caringbah in Sydney, NSW.

Government Recognition

Government or national recognition is the basic principle of the national vocational training framework in Australia. Certificate IV in Kinesiology
