

Frequently Asked Questions

How can I experience Kinesiology before I enrol?

The College of Neuro-Training offers free classes before enrolment. They usually go for 3 hours. You can attend more than once. You will receive a free Kinesiology manual and experience what it is like to perform a kinesiology muscle check.

How can I experience a Free Kinesiology session?

Student clinic offers new comers free sessions. This way you meet students at different levels, check out the campus and classes and be part of the Kinesiology and Neuro-Training community before you enroll. Each campus has different times that these student clinics and practicums are available.

What is Neuro-Training and what is Kinesiology?

Neuro-Training is a way of helping a person to recuperate and get beyond various events in life that unfortunately have conditioned them to respond in a predictable way.

The Neuro-Training is a model based on the universal laws that the person innately desires to heal themselves. The approach provides the philosophy, a working model, the tools, techniques and practices to train a person for long-term recuperation based on the latest research in neuroscience. It is the result of over 30 years of research and practice by Neuro-Training Pty Ltd, and is considered to be at the forefront of Neuro-Science.

The Neuro-Training approach is endorsed by Neuro-Training Pty Ltd, and accredited by the Australian Institute of Kinesiology (“AIK”) professional association. Kinesiology is the verification tool used to best direct the Neuro-training session. Many other students who have trained in Kinesiology elsewhere will go on to study the Neuro-Training approach and integrate the previous information using our Solution Based Model.

What is Neuro-Training and what is Kinesiology?

Neuro-Trainings approach is based on how we all heal and recuperate and not just techniques. While we use Kinesiology techniques throughout the Neuro-Training study, how we apply these techniques provides the client an individual focus for long-term recuperation.

Many years ago NT recognized that we are not built on techniques alone, rather, that we all express an inherent pattern of how we all heal and recuperate. In working with this universal pattern, the contexts from which we apply the changes have a much more long lasting effect. This contextual approach works with what is congruent for us all, regardless of our cultural differences, beliefs, attitudes or way in which we were raised. Neuro-Training considers our genetic and energetic based structure that determines the patterns of how we heal and get better.

What qualification do I receive?

The Diploma of Kinesiology (HLT52415) will qualify you as a Kinesiologist once every unit is complete. It is government recognized qualification.

The Diploma of Neuro-Training entitles you to be a more advanced Neuro-Trainer and recognized by professional associations at a higher level of expertise. It is not a government recognized qualification but is recognized by the Kinesiology Industry.

The Solution-Oriented Neuro-Training gives the practitioner the best model with which to assist clients on their recuperation journey. The model is a client-focused model that references an individual's patterns on how to best recuperate, rather than just being techniques.

The Diploma of Neuro-Training combines the Activation Certificate, The Recuperation Certificate and the Certificate of Solution Oriented Neuro-Training.

The Activation Certificate entitles you to study further other Neuro-Training Activation courses or train as a trainer of Neuro-Training. It's our smallest certificate and suited for those wishing a small experience.

The Recuperation Certificate enables you to earn using the NT recuperation clinic as you continue to learn more NT and what it takes to become a professional practitioner. You cannot work independently with this certificate but can work under supervision in our student practitioner clinics.

The Certificate of Solution Oriented Neuro-Training (SONT) entitles you to be a Neuro-Trainer with the knowledge of Solution Oriented Clinic focus. You are qualified to practice as a Neuro-Trainer and Natural Therapist. You can apply for and receive professional indemnity insurance at this level.

Are there other courses I can complete once I have completed my certificate or Diploma?

We have almost 50 different classes. Some classes combine Kinesiology and Neuro-Training, some only have Neuro-Training only (we refer to these as the activation classes).

Once you have done the first four days (Activation certificate) you may go on to study any other activation class that specializes in a specific ailment. In fact, you can actually do one day then try another one-day activation class that is outside of the activation certificate if you didn't want to achieve a certificate level right away.

For example we offer “Best Digest – for better digestion”, “Excel at Sports” or “Neuro-Power Training” for fitness and stamina or “Keen Mean Mind - for learning and memory. We offer many activation certificates that are independent of Kinesiology. Please contact us for more information and the entire list.

Any module or class listed on our courses at the *College* leads on to the Diploma of Neuro-Training and also the Diploma of Kinesiology.

The Diploma of Neuro-Training or any other Neuro-Training class after module 3 can lead you to study any class of your choice. Many other classes are offered by Neuro-Training combined with Kinesiology such as; Iridology and Neuro-Training, Astrology and Neuro-Training, Financial Intelligence and Neuro-Training.

When will the Kinesiology and or Neuro-Training courses start?

Is the course full-time or part-time?

The number of hours in the training is considered full time yet most campus timetables are scheduled for part-time class study with self-study done at home. Classes are typically held over a weekend or midweek, usually a month apart. Other modules such as communication or business management are self-study and completed at home.

What if I can't make one of the classes?

All Kinesiology classes require 100% attendance in most cases. The first 4 days (the Neuro-Training Activation Certificate) can be purchased on video if you miss any of the days. Some class dates may be flexible, depending on the class. More suitable dates or a catch up class may be arranged with your trainer if you are unable to attend.

How long do I have to complete the course?

Typically a student has 2-3 years within which to complete the Diploma of Kinesiology HLT52415.

What if I'm not sure that the course is for me?

The College offers the option of enrolling in one day or one class such as Module One (without the need to complete any assessments at a reduced price) to give you a taste of the course content and help with your decision.

How much is the course?

Do I pay the total of the course fees up front?

Payment for each module is requested at the beginning of each module/training weekend and requested 14 days prior to commencement of the module. An initial \$100 deposit secures your place at the time of enrolment.

Can I pay by payment plan?

Yes. A payment plan may be offered for those under financial challenge. Our payment plan works on the basis of monthly payments. There is a one off \$100 fee to use this plan. There is no interest charged for the payment plan. Each module must be paid in full before you can participate in that module.

Most students begin their payment plan a few months prior to the commencement of the course. Discuss this with your campus director during your pre enrolment interview and ask for a payment plan document.
